Volunteer CIRCLE Program  
Position Description**

<b>BRAVO (Bringing Reading to All through Volunteer Outreach)</b>	
<b>Hours</b>	Flexible.
<b>Time Commitment</b>	A minimum of 1-1/2 to 2 hours monthly for each person to whom the volunteer delivers is required.
<b>Location</b>	BRAVO patrons live in various areas throughout Lycoming County in private home or group care settings.
<b>Nature of Work</b>	Most BRAVO patrons are older, however, anyone with short term or long term disability is eligible for the program. The volunteer meets with the reader(s) to establish a relationship, develop a clear understanding of the reader's interests and needs, and to set up a delivery time which allows the volunteer to deliver and pick up materials, and to visit with their reader(s). Volunteers in long term care facilities help to promote the program and locate new patrons.
<b>Qualifications</b>	Ability to discuss with people their reading interests; patience, punctuality, and a friendly attitude are essential. Volunteers must appreciate older adults and enjoy working with them. Volunteers should have transportation available. A reading background and a familiarity with books is helpful but not essential.
